
Our Nation Still Stands!

PTSD Awareness Day is observed every year on June 27th

PTSD stands for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder and is a condition that many veterans and non-veterans alike suffer. PTSD can occur when someone experiences or witnesses a traumatic event. This condition wasn't always understood properly by the medical or military community, and Department of Defense press releases often point to earlier attempts to identify PTSD symptoms in the wake of service in World War 2, Vietnam, and other conflicts.

He felt that he had let the child down, and was not the responsible parent that any child would need. We got the particulars, contacted the utility and got the power restored – he is extremely grateful for the help provided by Veterans' Outreach.



Youngstown, Ohio

A call came in from our local VA Clinic. They were working with a veteran that was suffering from depression. They had been able to help him with housing. The problem was that the veteran's phone had been shut off. The VA staff was very concerned about the veteran being alone and unable to reach out, they also wanted to be sure that they could keep in touch with him.

They asked us if we could help with the phone to get it paid off and get the service on. We told them to send him straight here, we sent a staff person with him to the service provider, paid the bill, and immediately he had service again. Something that might seem small to some of us might very well have saved this veteran's life.
