Sarasota, Florida

A veteran who had been homeless until the VA Hud Vash program got him an apartment and paid the majority of the rental bill. With complex knee problems, a required hip replacement so that he can comfortably walk again, and radiation therapy for prostate cancer plus the fallout from the pandemic, he has been unable to work and asked for assistance on his utility bill. We immediately helped him out, lifted his spirits and he's scheduling the hip replacement.

Hartselle, Alabama

A veteran who was about to be released by a local hospital. He was not from the area, just passing through and ended up in the hospital. He needed two nights lodging to get well enough to continue his journey. We told him that we could help. We were able to reach out to our Bridges to Business group in Decatur

AL. They donated enough for a two night stay with a little spending money to boot. We picked the veteran up at the hospital and took him to his room. He is a good person who is down on his luck, and very grateful. We are blessed to have connections with good people that want to help veterans.

Navajo Code Talkers

The Navajo "code talkers" were recruited during the second World War to help communicate messages on the battlefield. Their language, which at the time was still unwritten, proved to be an uncrackable code. The Navajo code talkers, helped the United States win World War II. The Navajo language was the perfect language to use because it had no alphabet, and as a result, there were no materials the Japanese could use to learn it. By the end of the war, the code had been expanded from an initial 211 words to over 600 words. which the code talkers all committed to memory.

The United States Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) is a federal Cabinet-level agency that provides near-comprehensive healthcare services to eligible military veterans at VA medical centers and outpatient clinics located throughout the country; several non-healthcare benefits including disability compensation, vocational rehabilitation, education assistance, home loans, and life insurance; and provides burial and memorial benefits to eligible veterans and family members at 135 national cemeteries.
