New Corporate Office



Wow! It was hard to believe it had been 30 incredible years since we started our journey to help veterans in need. I was 40 when this mission began, fueled by a deep desire to assist homeless veterans in any way possible. Now, at the age of 70, I reflect on the remarkable journey alongside my wife, Teri, who joined me a couple of years into this noble cause.

Funding our program services to aid veterans with rent, food, car repairs, transportation, utilities, and more has been no small feat. Our commitment to providing immediate, no-red-tape assistance has been crucial. We've responded to emergencies, including suicide prevention, after personal interviews, jumping into action to support veterans in their time of need. Our collaboration with like-minded agencies, other non-profits, county offices, and VA entities has strengthened our mission, as we continue to be a safety net for veterans seeking help.

The year 2023 marked a significant transition for our charity and myself. Early in the year, we eagerly anticipated the development of our new corporate office, housed in the former National Headquarters of Arby's Corporation. The scale of the new space, 28,000 ft² across three two-story buildings on a 2.6-acre lot, was a substantial upgrade from our previous 3,600 ft² home. As we pondered how best to utilize this expansive space to enhance veterans' lives, Teri, with her deep understanding of our operations, spearheaded the renovation of our main building.

In addition to our regular service programs, she introduced the VO Depot—a boutique thrift store selling everything from cars to baby shoes. The Depot's purpose is to help support our financial services for veterans. The process involved clearing out surplus medical billing equipment, repurposing furniture, and undertaking significant renovations, including building walls, painting, flooring, electrical work, and security system upgrades.

Amidst these developments, I faced a personal challenge—back surgery that turned into a life-threatening ordeal, followed by a second surgery and ongoing rehabilitation. Teri, taking on the challenge and duty, orchestrated everything while managing our existing offices and crucial business operations. The pain and humility of this experience have been profound, but it became a testament to our dedication to the mission.

Our mission persists and grows stronger each day. More people are recognizing our work, and we are so grateful for the support, and we hope others will consider joining us in some way. While there are many ideas for the property's future, we'll keep Liberty in suspense until they become a reality!

I had no idea that this would be my life's work, and credit for the mission's success goes to the grace of God, and then to my wonderful wife and partner, Teri. A heartfelt thank you to our Board of Directors, employees, fundraisers, volunteers, and supporters for sticking with us and contributing to the success of a very worthwhile charity that truly makes a difference.
