Six World Boxing Champions Come Together to Honor Our Veterans Veterans are the backbone of our nation, having sacrificed so much to protect our freedoms. It is our duty to honor and support them in every way possible. That is exactly why "Fight Night" was such a meaningful event—it was more than just a fundraiser; it was a tribute to the brave men and women who have served our country. This incredible event was made possible by none other than World Champion Ray "Boom Boom" Mancini. Ray saw a special segment about Veterans' Outreach on a local TV station, Veterans' Voices, which aired on Veterans Day. Our Executive Director, Teri Ely, was featured on the show, sharing our mission and the ways we serve veterans in need. The very next day, Ray reached out to her, offering to host his "Fight Night" event to honor our veterans.

The Ray "Boom Boom" Mancini Foundation orchestrated the event, and it was truly remarkable. Ray invited former world champions, including Larry Holmes, Buster Douglas, Gerry Cooney, Michael Spinks, Micky Ward, and Kelly Pavlik. Each of these champions came together not just for the love of boxing, but to show their deep respect for our veterans.

Ray's father, Lenny, was also a tremendous boxer—the original "Boom Boom." However, his career was put on hold when he joined the war effort in 1941. Unfortunately, after returning from service, his injuries prevented him from continuing his boxing career. This deep connection to military service is why Ray holds such profound respect and honor for our veterans.

At Veterans' Outreach, we have dedicated 31 years to supporting those who have sacrificed for our country. From emergency assistance to ongoing programs that help veterans rebuild their lives, we are committed to giving back to those who gave so much. Events like "Fight Night" help us continue this important mission. On a personal note, my oldest brother, Richard "Dick" Ely, was a Golden Glove Champion, known as "Sluggo" in Columbus. He grew up in a rough neighborhood and was a fierce competitor. He later joined the Army at just 17 years old. My father, a Pearl Harbor survivor, suffered from PTSD and alcoholism, which made life difficult for our family. Sadly, my brother passed away almost four years ago from Agent Orange exposure.

My brother, "Sluggo," would have been in his glory—he knew all of those champions. He, like so many other veterans, served with honor and made sacrifices that should never be forgotten.

Veterans' Outreach is deeply honored to have been selected for this once-in-a-lifetime event dedicated to our nation's heroes. A heartfelt thank you to Ray, the champions, and his wife, Tina, for making this extraordinary night possible. Most importantly, thank you to our veterans—you are the reason we do what we do.
